4. Kiruga describes his transition from one who argued for his faith to one who pursued a gospel of peace. Do you find it difficult to share your beliefs without arguing or becoming defensive? How can we embody a gospel of peace in our own communities?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-20. How would you define ambassador? How can you be a better ambassador in your context?
